Call for financial contributions

As preparations for **Geneva Cyber Week 2026** move forward, UNIDIR welcomes **voluntary financial contributions** to support complementary efforts that enhance the week's accessibility, visibility and post-event impact.

Building on the momentum of last year's inaugural edition – which engaged nearly 1,900 participants from over 100 countries across governments, international organizations, academia, civil society, and the private sector – **Geneva Cyber Week** has demonstrated strong and growing international interest in advancing practical dialogue on key cyber issues.

In 2026, financial support will help expand and deepen the week's impact through additional efforts including:

- Broader participation, bringing more diverse perspectives into global cyber discussions
- Enhanced accessibility, supporting more equitable engagement for all participants
- Stronger communications and outreach, increasing visibility and global reach
- Post-event outputs, such as knowledge products, reusable content, and (where feasible) recordings and/or livestreaming of selected sessions

As an institute funded through voluntary contributions, UNIDIR relies on the generous support of donors to carry out its mandate and activities. In the context of **Geneva Cyber Week 2026**, such contributions will support complementary activities that enhance participation, accessibility, visibility, and post-event follow-up.
